- ◆ Counselling, guidance and home visits
- ◆ Use of games and sports items
- ◆ Teaching materials, eg blackboards, chalk, drums for worship

When funding allows, we also provide:

- ◆ Scholastic materials, eg exercise books, pens
- ◆ School fees
- ◆ Medical support and treatment
- ◆ Start up tools for vocational training

### Achievements:

- ◆ Improved health among children
- ◆ Increased self-esteem, confidence & behaviour
- ◆ Children are given hope for their futures
- ◆ Opportunity to visit new places, eg when they are chosen to attend the annual residential camp
- ◆ This project has enabled some children to complete their education and some have taken courses in Motor Mechanics, Nursing, Driving, Plumbing and are now able to support themselves.

Children attend the project on Saturdays and also on Wednesdays during school holidays. It costs a minimum of £100 per month to support 100 children.

### That's just £1 per child per month!

However, we are committed to sending out more than this minimum amount to ensure that as many children as possible also benefit from the provision of scholastic materials, school fees, medical support and start up tools for vocational training.
